

Hygiene, Arrival and Practical Arrangements

For Pupils in School from September

- Your child should only attend school **if they are well**. Covid 19 has a range of symptoms, but can include tiredness, a new dry cough and a fever. If someone in your family has these symptoms, you must self-isolate.

- Please ensure that your child **washes their hands** well before leaving the house
- Your child should bring essential items with them: coat, lunch, reading book, glasses, sun-block – all stationery will be provided by school.
- Walk or cycle if you can and avoid using public transport if possible. If you do need to use it then adults and children 11 and over must wear a mask.

- If your child wears a **mask** to travel to school and it is disposable, then please **use the bin** provided near the gate. If it is re-usable please put it in a named plastic bag until the end of the day.
- Please can only **one** parent come with their child and leave the site as soon as possible to avoid large crowds gathering.
- If you are waiting, please stand away from others.
- Please follow the **one-way** system in operation:
 - KS2- in through the large double gates and out up the steps through small gate by the upper hall
 - Y1 and Y2 – in through the small blue gate by the car park and out of the electronic security gate (Y1 may use the small temporary gate in the corner of the Reception playground on 2nd September to enter the Reception playground for the first day back)
 - New Reception – in through the small temporary gate you have been using and out of the electronic security gate.
- As far as possible, please phone if you need to talk to us rather than talking to the staff to whom you are handing your child to.
- Only one person is allowed in the area by the office at a time.
- It will make a massive difference to us if you can keep to your child's allocated arrival and pick up times.
