A Group for Parents/Carers of Children with Behaviour Difficulties

Do you have a child aged 2-10 years?
Do you sometimes find being a parent/carer tough and stressful?
Do you find it difficult to manage your child's behaviour?

Would you like to learn more about how to manage your child's behaviour,
have a better relationship with your child, and meet other parents/carers
in the same situation?

If YES, then you are not alone - lots of families have similar worries and
experience these kind of difficulties.

What is the Incredible Years?
The Incredible Years was created to help parents/carers manage their child's
difficult behaviour including conditions such as ADHD. Often, these behaviours
impact on the whole family, leaving everyone, including the child, feeling
negatively about themselves. This course will improve your relationship with your
child and increase yours, and your child's, confidence.
