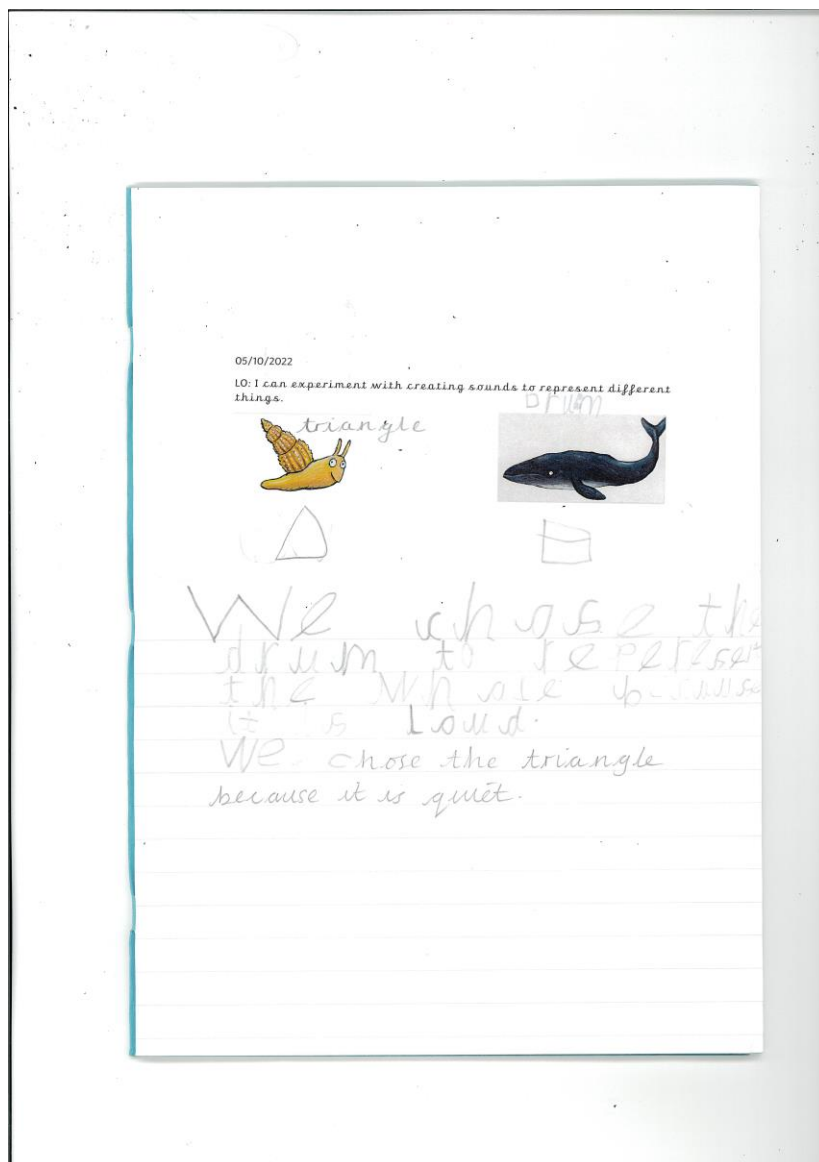

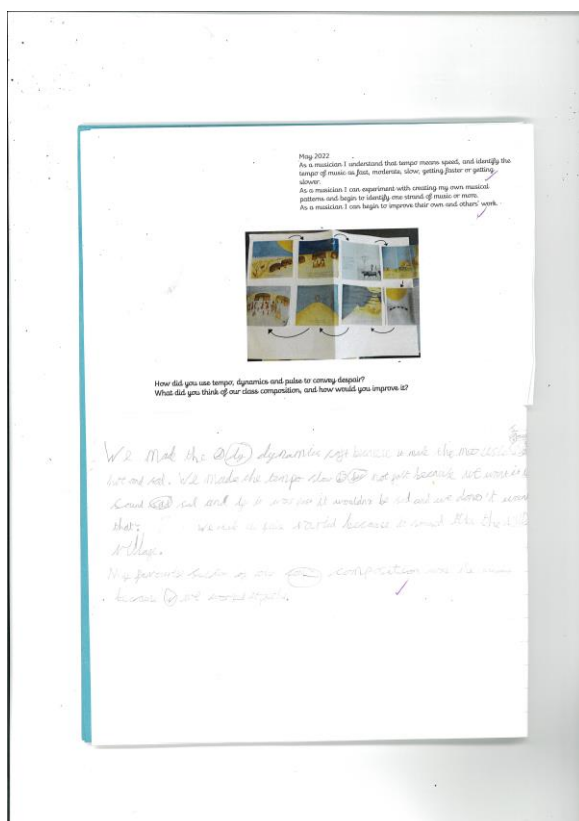
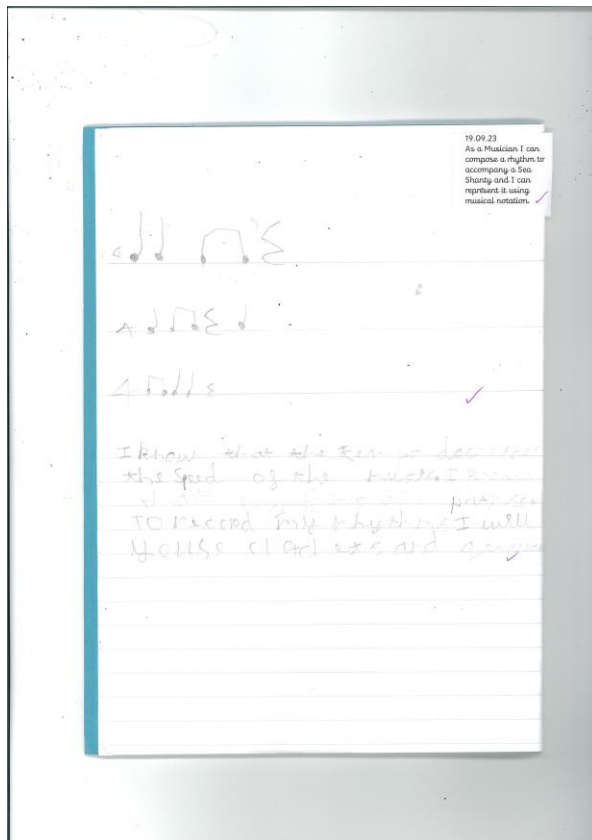
### Year 1


